#### **FUNDING**

- City of Raton—\$207,658.00—4% of the city budget
- Library Building Fund—\$340,412.00
- State Grant-in-Aid—Awarded \$7,780 for 2014-2015 FY, funded yearly by the NM
  Legislature, varying amounts—To be used in ways to promote library services to the
  public (collections, internet/computer hardware/software, promotions and
  programming, etc.)

This grant is paid in alternating years by a lump sum or by two checks yearly. It requires completing a yearly State Library Report and meeting the criteria of funding from the City of Raton to be spent yearly on the collection in the amount of \$1.50 per person in our legal service area.

• GO Bond Funds 2012 and 2014—Grant amount of GOB 2012 is \$16,599.20, with a current remainder of \$8,168.89 to be spent by April 1, 2016. GOB 2014 funds in the amount of \$16,434.86 are available and must be spent by April 1, 2018.

These funds are provided by the voters of New Mexico. It Is a reimbursement process, meaning that items and services must be purchased and paid for by the City of Raton and will then be reimbursed. These funds may be spent on "Equipment" relating to computer/internet services and on "Library Resources", library holdings intended for public use.

• Marge Leason Estate—\$500.00 yearly, administered by the Presbyterian Church.

#### **FUNDING CONTINUED**

#### ERate—Federally funded, varying amounts per year

These funds pay 80% of the library internet, phone and fax services. The refund comes after the fiscal year is finished. The library hires International Computer Corporation of Santa Fe to do the complex, year long application and reimbursement process and the library pays them 22% of the refund amount.

• William H. Darden and Katheryn T. Darden Trust— \$166,53.00, remaining funds of \$124,025.00 Notification came in April 2014.

This bequest is administered by the Darden Trustees Larry McQueary and Robert Harris. The items and services are purchased, received or installed, and the bills are paid by the trustees.
