**CITY OF RATON, NEW MEXICO
APPLICATION FOR COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT PROGRAM (CO-OP)
FUNDING TO NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION - DISTRICT IV
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016-2017**

WHEREAS, small municipal agencies such as the City of Raton have very limited resources for maintenance and improvement of local street, drainage and transportation infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City of Raton has recognized the importance of the Cooperative Agreement program for funding enhancement of such infrastructure maintenance and improvement; and

WHEREAS, maintenance and improvement of local street, drainage and transportation infrastructure is critical to the stability and economic development of the community of Raton; and

WHEREAS, resurfacing of local streets is a necessary infrastructure maintenance measure that has been identified as a high priority by the City of Raton and is an important component of the 2016 city street improvement program; and

WHEREAS, The City of Raton proposes a street resurfacing project with a total project cost of \$100,000; including NMDOT funding of \$75,000 and City of Raton funding in the amount of \$25,000

WHEREAS, in anticipation of approved and full funding by the New Mexico Department of Transportation, the City of Raton hereby certifies and will budget for \$25,000 in required matching funds to complete this essential project.

NOW THEREFORE, the City of Raton requests \$100,000 in total project funding from the New Mexico Department of Transportation for resurfacing of high priority city streets, and pledges in anticipation of approved funding \$25,000 in required matching funds to complete this essential project.
