**DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AWARENESS MONTH
OCTOBER 2017**

WHEREAS, the month of October 2017 has been declared as the "Domestic Violence Awareness Month"; and

WHEREAS, the crime of domestic violence violates an individual's privacy and dignity, security and humanity, due to systematic use of physical, emotional, sexual, psychological and economic control and/or abuse including abuse to children and the elderly; and

WHEREAS, the family violence results from the use of force or threat to achieve and maintain control over others in intimate relationships and abuse of power in society fosters battering by perpetuating conditions which condone violence and only a coordinated community effort will put a stop to this heinous crime; and

WHEREAS, domestic violence costs the nation billions of dollars annually in medical expenses, police, court costs, shelters, foster care, sick leave, absenteeism and non-productivity; and

WHEREAS, the Raton Alternatives to Violence and shelters throughout the State of New Mexico are working together to provide effective intervention, prevention, community education, and support to build a non-violent family environment in our City.

NOW THEREFORE, do I, Sandra Mantz, Mayor, of the City of Raton, New Mexico do hereby proclaim the month of October, 2017 as:
